Needs-based funding

Resolution 24-40: Réginald Manning – Joyce Malenfant

WHEREAS the current economy has stretched the financial capabilities of Municipalities and taxpayers to the point where they do not have sufficient financial resources to meet the ongoing demands of everyday living, and;

WHEREAS the current housing accelerator fund provides financial support for small communities and, while water and distribution systems are considered eligible under program guidelines, one of the primary criteria for this funding is the ability to prove that the funds will accelerate the development of of housing stock on the water or distribution system, and;

WHEREAS many smaller communities are not experiencing the level of growth necessary to meet the requirements of the program, and;

WHEREAS the water and wastewater systems in those communities represents a higher cost to operate per capita than the systems in larger built-up areas, and;

WHEREAS the cost of maintaining those systems on a user-pay basis is creating undo financial hardship for the limited number of residents on those systems;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council for the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté hereby supports Resolution no. 38-02-2024 made by Council for the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands, requesting that the Province of Ontario implement a funding stream for water and wastewater systems that primarily utilizes operational and financial need as a criteria, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands and to our local parliament representatives, MPP Guy Bourgouin and MP Carol Hughes.

Recycling - ineligible sources

<u>Resolution 24-41</u>: Joyce Malenfant – Réginald Manning WHEREAS under Ontario Regulation 391/21, Blue Box producers are fully accountable and financially responsible for their products and packaging once they reach their end of life and are disposed of, for "eligible" sources only, and; WHEREAS "ineligible" sources, which producers are not responsible for, include businesses, places of worship, daycares, campgrounds, public-facing and internal areas of municipalowned buildings and not-for-profit organizations, such as shelters and food banks, and;

WHEREAS should a municipality continue to provide services to the "ineligible" sources, the municipality will be required to oversee the collection, transportation and processing of the recycling, assuming 100% of the costs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council for the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté hereby support Resolution no. 2024-52 of Council for the Township of Perry, requesting that the Province amend Ontario Regulation 391/21 so that Blue Box producers are responsible for the end-of-life management of recycling products from all sources, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honourable Doug Ford, Premier of Ontario, the Honourable Andrea Khanjin, Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, the Township of Perry and to our local parliament representatives, MPP Guy Bourgouin and MP Carol Hughes.

Agriculture project report Resolution 24-42: Joyce Malenfant – Réginald Manning WHEREAS the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté is a Member Organization in the Northeast Community Network ("NeCN"); AND WHEREAS the NeCN is the owner of certain confidential information pertaining to the Claybelt Agriculture Development Project (the "Project"); AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté wishes to access and receive confidential information relating to the Project for the purposes of review; AND WHEREAS it is a requirement of NeCN that Member Municipalities appoint a municipal representative to sit on the NeCN Board of Directors: AND WHEREAS it is a requirement that NeCN Board Members and their Authorized Representatives enter into a non-disclosure agreement in the form attached hereto as Schedule A to this Resolution (the "Agreement") prior to accessing and receiving confidential information relating to the Project;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the terms of the Agreement, a written request for disclosure ("Request for Disclosure") in the form of a municipal council resolution including the name, position, organization, contact information, relation to the NeCN Board Member and a statement regarding the reasoning behind, and justification for the request is required;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté wishes to designate certain individuals as its Authorized Representatives and submit a Request for Disclosure in accordance with the Agreement;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté appoints the individuals listed in the Request for Disclosure attached hereto as Schedule B to this Resolution as its Authorized Representatives for the purpose of receiving confidential information respecting the Project from the NeCN pursuant to the Agreement;

2. The execution and delivery of the Agreement by Marc Dupuis, Mayor and Guylaine Coulombe, CAO/Clerk of the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté as Receiving Party is ratified and approved;

3. The execution and delivery of the Agreement by the individuals listed in the Request for Disclosure attached hereto as Schedule B to this Resolution as the Municipality's Authorized Representatives is ratified and approved; and

4. The Request for Disclosure attached hereto as Schedule B to this Resolution is ratified and approved by the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté for submission to the NeCN in accordance with the Agreement, together with a copy of this Resolution.

Recycling – 2025 transitionResolution 24-43: Réginald Manning – Joyce MalenfantWHEREAS Circular Materials is the Producer Responsibility
Organization (PRO) that administers the Blue Box Common
Collection System in Ontario, and;
WHEREAS the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté will transition
its blue box recycling services to the new system on January 1st,
2025, and;

	 WHEREAS the 2020 data call does not represent an adequate estimate of the volume or of the costs of the recycling services for Mattice – Val Côté because the depot was only available to residents for a period of three months in 2020, and; WHEREAS municipal staff is currently addressing the abovenoted issue with Circular Materials; NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council for the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté is opting in with Circular Materials for the 2025 transition year, and; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, to that end, Council for the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté is prepared to enter into a Depot Operations Agreement with Circular Materials and; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Mattice – Val Côté depot remain unstaffed and in its present location for 2025.
