THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MATTICE - VAL CÔTÉ

BY-LAW NO. 775

Being a By-law to classify municipal highways and to establish minimum maintenance standards pertaining to them

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to classify municipal highways and to clarify the distinction between local roads, summer roads and unopened road allowances;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to establish minimum maintenance standards for all municipal highways under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Mattice – Val Côté;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Mattice - Val Côté enacts as follows:

1. THAT the following definitions apply:

Local road: means a common and public highway which is maintained on a year-round basis. It includes any bridge, trestle, viaduct or other structure forming part of the highway and, except as otherwise provided, includes a portion of a highway;

Summer road: means a road allowance on which no winter maintenance is performed. Summer/seasonal upkeep is only performed on summer roads from June 1st to October 15th.

Unopened road allowance: means a road allowance that is vested in the Municipality but that is not opened or assumed by the Municipality for maintenance purposes. Such roads are used at the user's risk;

Class 4: means a public highway classified as Class 4 in Ontario Regulation 239/02;

Class 5: means a public highway classified as Class 5 in Ontario Regulation 239/02;

Class 6: means a public highway, classified as Class 6 in Ontario Regulation 239/02, with an average annual daily traffic of 0 to 49 motor vehicles and to which the minimum maintenance standards for municipal highways outlined in the Regulation do not apply.

2. THAT all roads vested in the Municipality be classified as per Schedule "A", attached hereto.

- 3. THAT all local roads be considered Class 5 roads, save and except 2nd Street which is considered to be a Class 4.
- 4. THAT the minimum maintenance standards for municipal highways, described in Ontario Regulation 239/02 and outlined in Schedule "B" attached hereto, apply to all Class 4 and Class 5 roads within the Municipality.
- 5. THAT the following limited maintenance standards apply to summer roads:

a) minimal gravelling, grading, brush cutting and ditching, sufficient to allow for the passing of vehicles during the months without snow;

b) patrolling, at the discretion of the Public Works Supervisor, as needed, and not less than once a month during the months without snow;

c) no major repairs to culverts need be performed. Should such repairs be required for public safety, Council may decide to eliminate all or a portion of the road allowance from its summer maintenance schedule;

d) a service standard below that which is provided for a year-round maintained highway.

- 6. THAT signage be posted at the entrance of each Summer Road and of each Unopened Road Allowance, with the wording outlined in Schedule "A" for said classifications.
- 7. THIS By-law repeals By-law no. 751.
